

Event Sanctioning Conditions & Terms

USA Ultimate is proud to sanction ultimate tournaments in conjunction with event organizers. We offer many resources to help organizers host a successful, fun and safe event. The organizer must meet specific requirements, laid out in the tournament sanctioning agreement and contract. If these requirements are not met consequences will be incurred.

Monetary penalties will be incurred for first time offenses. For repeat and/or egregious offenses USA Ultimate reserves the right to deny sanctioning for any future event associated with the host organizer and/or organization.

For a first time non-egregious offense there will be a minimum of a \$100 penalty fee added to any sanctioning fee.

Things that could result in these consequences include but are not limited to:

- Missing Memberships
- Missing Waivers
- Undersized fields
- Poor field conditions
- Poor safety conditions
- Continuous lack of communication with USA Ultimate and/or teams
- Missing important USA Ultimate deadlines
- Not providing water to teams (If this is not possible be sure to communicate that so teams can prepare)
- Not providing bathrooms to participants
- Failing to provide gender and division equitable treatment, communication, service and amenities to any division included in the event
- Inadequate game round times and/or point caps for events with a specified minimum
