# **USA Ultimate Triple Crown Tour (Club) Championship Series Sectional Coordinator Volunteer Job Description**



#### **MISSION STATEMENT:**

The mission of USA Ultimate is to advance the sport of ultimate in the United States by enhancing and promoting character, community and competition. As a Sectional Coordinator (SC), you will be directly working towards growing our sport in your local section!

#### **DESCRIPTION:**

The SC oversees the planning and execution of the competition and administrative aspects of the sectional championship for their respective division (men's, mixed, women's). This includes communicating with teams in that section and event Tournament Directors (TDs), creating event schedules and seeding (with assistance), and ensuring accurate reporting of scores and final standings.

#### **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Assist with securing bids for sectional championships from local tournament organizers and/or field sites, and with securing a Tournament Director to run day-of logistics (this can also be you!)
  - o Most SCs work with the other divisions' SCs in their section to find a location that fits all three divisions
- Communicate with local team managers to ensure they are aware of deadlines and processes for participating in the USA Ultimate Postseason Championship Series
- Work with the TD and your division's Regional Coordinator to set the schedule and seeding for the tournament and upload/create them in the online USA Ultimate system (AKA Score Reporter)
- Be available during the sectional championship to assist the Tournament Director with ensuring USAU's guidelines are being followed and addressing issues, if any, that may arise (i.e. rescheduling rounds due to weather, un-rostered players, etc.)
- Ensure that accurate scores are reported by the TD and update the event with final standings
- Provide feedback to USAU on how to improve the Series and/or the Coordinator roles
- Coordinate Series event disc sales (optional)

#### **REQUIREMENTS:**

- Must be in good standing with USA Ultimate (i.e. no suspensions)
- Access to email ability and willingness to respond to email 2-3 times per week through July, and 4-5 times per week
  from early August through the end of the sectional championship
- Access to internet and USA Ultimate platform for the months of August and September
- Adhere to principles of the mission of USA Ultimate
