Equity, diversity and inclusion (EDI) are critical to the integrity of our sport, and USA Ultimate is committed to increasing access to and participation in the sport, particularly amongst youth in underrepresented communities.

Job Description

The LGBTQ+ Advisory Council acts as a sounding board for ideas on how to best support LGBTQ+ ultimate athletes and coaches. This group consists of 3-4 LGBTQ+ members of the ultimate community who represent different backgrounds, ages, gender identities and geographic locations, while giving input to USA Ultimate on a variety of issues, including the areas of focus listed below.

The LGBTQ+ Advisory Council is an advisory group, not a decision-making body. Members are asked to share their perspective and experience, as well as share feedback from the broader ultimate community.

The LGBTQ+ Advisory Council is appointed by the USA Ultimate EDI Team leadership. This volunteer position comes with a free USA Ultimate membership and an honorarium of \$1,500 annually.

Responsibilities

- Attend quarterly video calls with the USA Ultimate LGBTQ+ Advisory Council staff liaison.
- Review and provide feedback on USA Ultimate programs and projects that are focused on supporting and retaining LGBTQ+ athletes and coaches, especially transgender and non-binary community members.
- Share with USA Ultimate issues or areas of concern affecting the LGBTQ+ ultimate community.

Areas of Focus

- Support and Inclusion for LGBTQ+ Athletes, Coaches and Community Members
- Education for Coaches, Staff, Observers, and Event/Competition Organizers
- Divisional Inclusion and Alignment
